Week #4 Summary: In this hands-on summer camp, students will explore alternative photographic processes while connecting with nature and developing their creative eye. We'll start each day with photo walks—whether around the neighborhood, local parks, or hidden city gems—to capture unique images with phones or digital cameras. Then, we'll head back to the studio to transform those photos into digital negatives, ready for the darkroom-inspired fun to begin.

Campers will dive into classic, sun-powered processes like cyanotype and SolarFast printing, learning how to make one-of-a-kind blueprints and richly toned prints using only light, water, and their imagination.

By the end of the week, students will leave with a mini portfolio of handcrafted prints, a deeper appreciation for photography's roots, and the skills to keep creating long after camp ends.

No previous photography experience needed—just curiosity and a love for making art!
